§ 1 Information on the collection of personal data

(a) In the following we provide information about the collection of personal data when using our website. Personal data are all data that can be related to you personally, e.g. name, address, e-mail addresses, user behaviour.

(b) The persons responsible in accordance with Art. 4 Para. 7 EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) are Mr. Lothar Koeninger and Mr. Uwe Makowski as Managing Directors of Oberflaechentechnik Koeninger GmbH & Co. KG in Brieselang (for further details see legal notice). The company does not have a data protection officer.

(c) When you contact us by e-mail or post, the data you provide (your e-mail address, your name and your telephone number) will be stored by us in order to answer your questions. We delete the data arising in this context after the storage is no longer necessary or restrict processing if there are legal obligations to retain data.

(d) If we wish to use commissioned service providers for individual functions of our offer, we will inform you in detail about the respective processes below. We will also state the specified criteria for the storage period. Your data will not be used for advertising purposes.

§ 2 Your rights

(a) You have the following rights in relation to personal data concerning you: Right of information, right of rectification or erasure, right to limit processing, right to object to processing, right to transfer of data.

(b) You also have the right to complain to a data protection supervisory authority about the processing of your personal data by us. § 3 Collection of personal data when visiting our website

(a) When using our website for purely informational purposes, only the personal data that your browser sends to our server is collected. If you wish to view our website, we only collect the following data, which is technically necessary for us to display our website and to guarantee stability and security (legal basis is Art. 6 Para. 1 S.1 lit. f DSGVO): IP address, date and time of the request, time zone difference to GMT, content of the request (specific page), access status/HTTP status code, amount of data transferred in each case, website from which the request comes, browser, operating system and its interface, language and version of the browser software.

(b) In addition to the data mentioned above, cookies are stored on your computer when you use our website. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your hard drive in accordance with the browser you are using and through which certain information is transmitted to the party that sets the cookie (in this case us). Cookies cannot execute programs or transfer viruses to your computer. They are used to make the Internet offer more user-friendly and effective.

(c) Use of cookies: Apart from the technically necessary cookies, we do not use any other text files or social media plug-ins.
